The National Household Survey: A First!

The Census activities are well underway and a majority of citizens have already completed their form.

For the first time, in conjunction with the 2011 Census, Statistics Canada will undertake a major new survey. Indeed, one in three households will be invited to participate in the new National Household Survey (NHS).

For those who have not already answered online, the NHS questionnaires will be delivered in early June. The information collected in the NHS will provide data needed to plan and support family services, housing, roads and public transportation, and skills training for employment. They are important to provide a detailed and comprehensive picture of your community.

For information to be available for future planning and decision making, it is important that all residents who receive the NHS complete the questionnaire.

As for the Census, a series of recalls as well as door-to-door follow-ups will be conducted for households who won't have completed their questionnaire.
